## **LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE:**

- **1.** Waterways Council, Inc.'s Hill Day on Feb 8th: Attended by David Podurgiel, Robert McCallister, Shane Checkan, Josh Konesni, James Guttman, Scott Harshman and Mary Ann Bucci Priorities:
  - Continue to support Upper Ohio River Navigation System & Lower Mon Projects
  - Oppose additional taxation, tolling, and lockage fees
  - Expressed appreciation for the 65/35 cost-share change and permanency, and potential opportunities to take it to 75/25 cost-share

## 2. Congressional Appropriations

- Both of our US Senators, Bob Casey and John Fetterman, are accepting programmatic and congressionally directed spending Fiscal Year 2024 Appropriations Requests with submission <u>deadlines of March 17th</u>
- Congressman Guy Reschenthaler, Mike Kelly, and GT Thompson are also taking requests -Checking with the offices of Chris Deluzio and Summer Lee as well
- 3. Beaver County Chamber of Commerce's Congressional Breakfast with Congressman Chris Deluzio is Tuesday, April 11<sup>th</sup> at 7:30am Location TBD
- 4. US Army Corps planning Allegheny River meeting later this month and this spring
- 5. Governor Josh Shapiro's first state budget was presented on March 7:
  - Proposes total budget for 2023-2024 Fiscal year of \$44.4 billion 3.6% increase
  - Includes a \$23.8 million investment in workforce training and apprenticeship programs and strengthening skills-building programs
  - Contains no new tax increases and calls for the elimination of mobile phone taxes
