Allegheny River**

Robert Clemente Bridge/Sixth Street Bridge (0.6):

A containment system is installed below low steel and follows the contour of the bridge. Vertical clearance is reduced **approximately 1-foot for the middle, 100 feet of the navigation span**. A work barge will be located outside of the navigation channel and will not affect navigation. Mariners are advised to transit the bridge with extreme caution. LNM 38-22

Karns Island Upper Light (27.4):

The Coast Guard is proposing the following Aid to Navigation change: Discontinue Karns Island Upper Light (LLNR-280) at mile 27.4, Right Descending Bank, in approximate position 40-39-09.171N 079-41-32.511W. Ohio River**

10th Street Wheeling Highway Bridge/Wheeling Suspension Bridge (90.3):

Bridge Maintenance continuing through June 2023, the vertical clearance may **be reduced by 2 feet** due to maintenance being performed on the bridge. Monongahela River**

Smithfield Street Bridge (0.8):

A containment system is installed and **will hang approximately 1.5 feet, below low steel**, following the contour of the bridge. LNM 33-22



- -When your renewing your certificates, make sure you are using Coast Guard National Vessel Documentation Center (NVDC). We know that there are multiple organizations/ websites that you can use, however there has been a high number of mis-documentation. If you have any questions, please call our office.
- -Coast Guard investigators pursue administrative enforcement actions to suspend or revoke the merchant mariner credentials held by mariners who harm others or threaten the safety of the marine transportation system by creating toxic work environments on their vessels. (<u>Coast Guard Investigative Service remains ready to investigate all allegations of sexual misconduct in the maritime domain Maritime Commons</u>)
- Recent changes to the law now require the responsible entity of a vessel, defined as the owner, master, or managing operator, to report any complaint or incident of harassment, sexual harassment, or sexual assault to the Coast Guard that violates company policy. To help facilitate reporting, the Coast Guard has consolidated reporting for all types of sexual misconduct and established multiple reporting options as detailed in the below graphic.
