Membership Meeting January 11, 2023

- River Ice: There has been little to no impacts reported and a favorable forecast was issued on 12-31-22.
- Industry experienced a period of extreme winter weather with temperatures becoming dangerously low with extreme wind chills. Several companies elected to stop operations until the temperatures became safe for the crews to work.
- Several days of fog followed the extreme cold weather slowing industry down but no major impacts reported.
- This past week Industry experienced a round of High water with no major impacts reported.
- Currently there are no major delays at any of the locks in the Pittsburgh District.
- River predictions show that all rivers are falling and are returning to normal operating levels.
- There have been communications between the WAP and Corps. concerning dredging at Hannibal lock prior to the scheduled outage.
