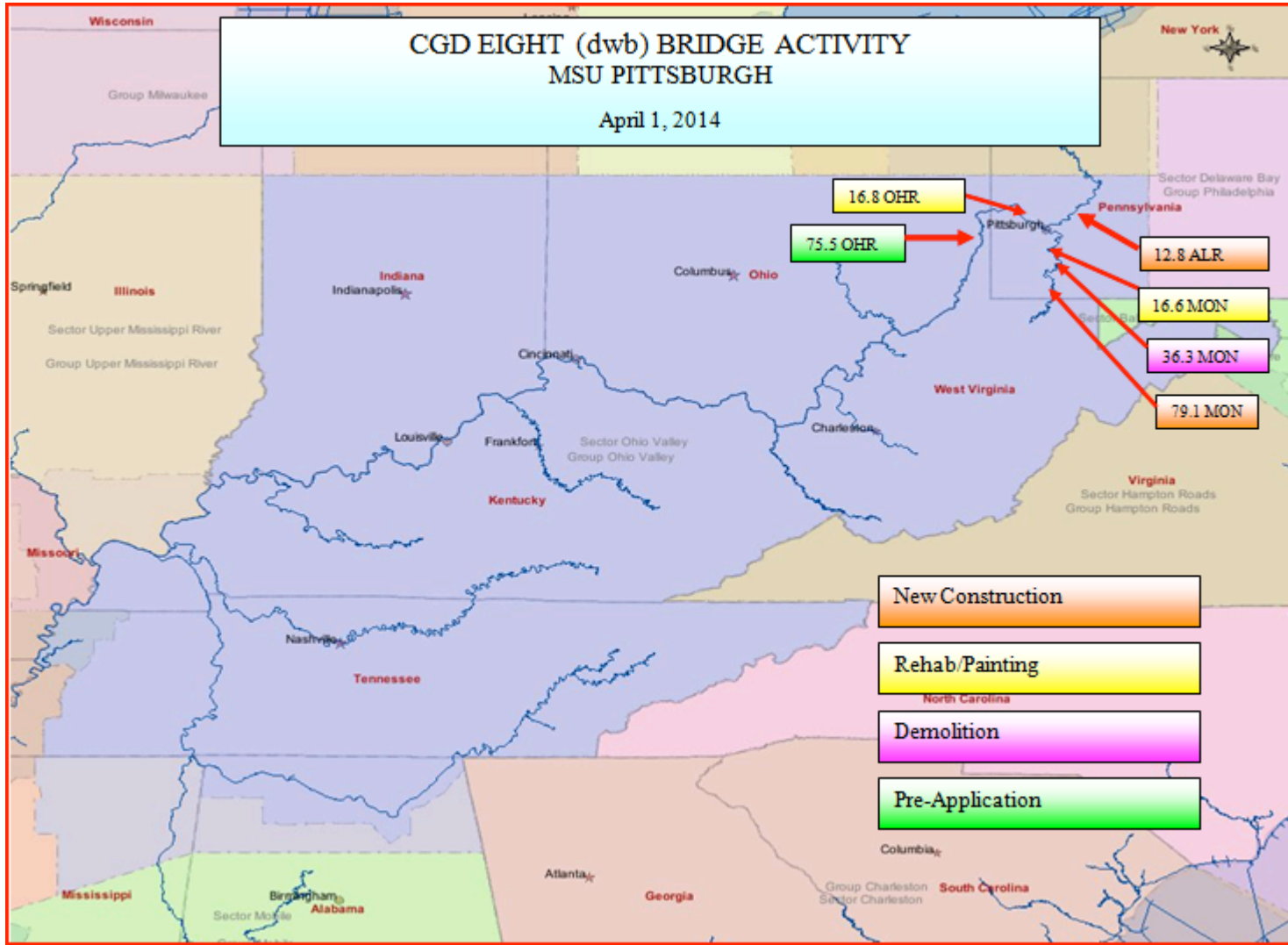

<u>Bridge</u>	<u>Waterway</u>	<u>Mile</u>	<u>Description</u>
Oakmont Bridge	Allegheny	12.8	Cofferdam construction has begun, Monday through Saturday daylight hours until October 22, 2015. 375-foot navigation channel will be maintained during construction.
William D. Mansfield Memorial Bridge	Monongahela	16.6	A containment system extends 3 feet below low steel for a reduced vertical clearance of 62.3 feet above pool stage. Work will be conducted from 7:00 a.m. until 5:00 pm., Monday through Saturday. Mariners are urged to transit the bridge with caution.
Webster-Donora Bridge	Monongahela	36.3	Bridge is closed to land traffic. Bidding to take place in May for demolition. No replacement currently planned.
Masontown Bridge Replacement	Monongahela	79.1	Pier Construction of Left and Right Descending channel piers is underway. Channel is clear of obstruction, and there remains a clearance of 344ft.
Ambridge-Aliquippa Bridge	Ohio	16.8	Containment extends 3 feet below the low steel for a reduced clearance of 75.5 ft until May 2014. Contact the Trumbull Corp. at (724) 333-6542 or (412) 292-9642, for status.
Proposed New Bridge	Ohio	75.5	Pre-Application stage for bridge construction. New bridge to provide 800 ft of horizontal clearance.
