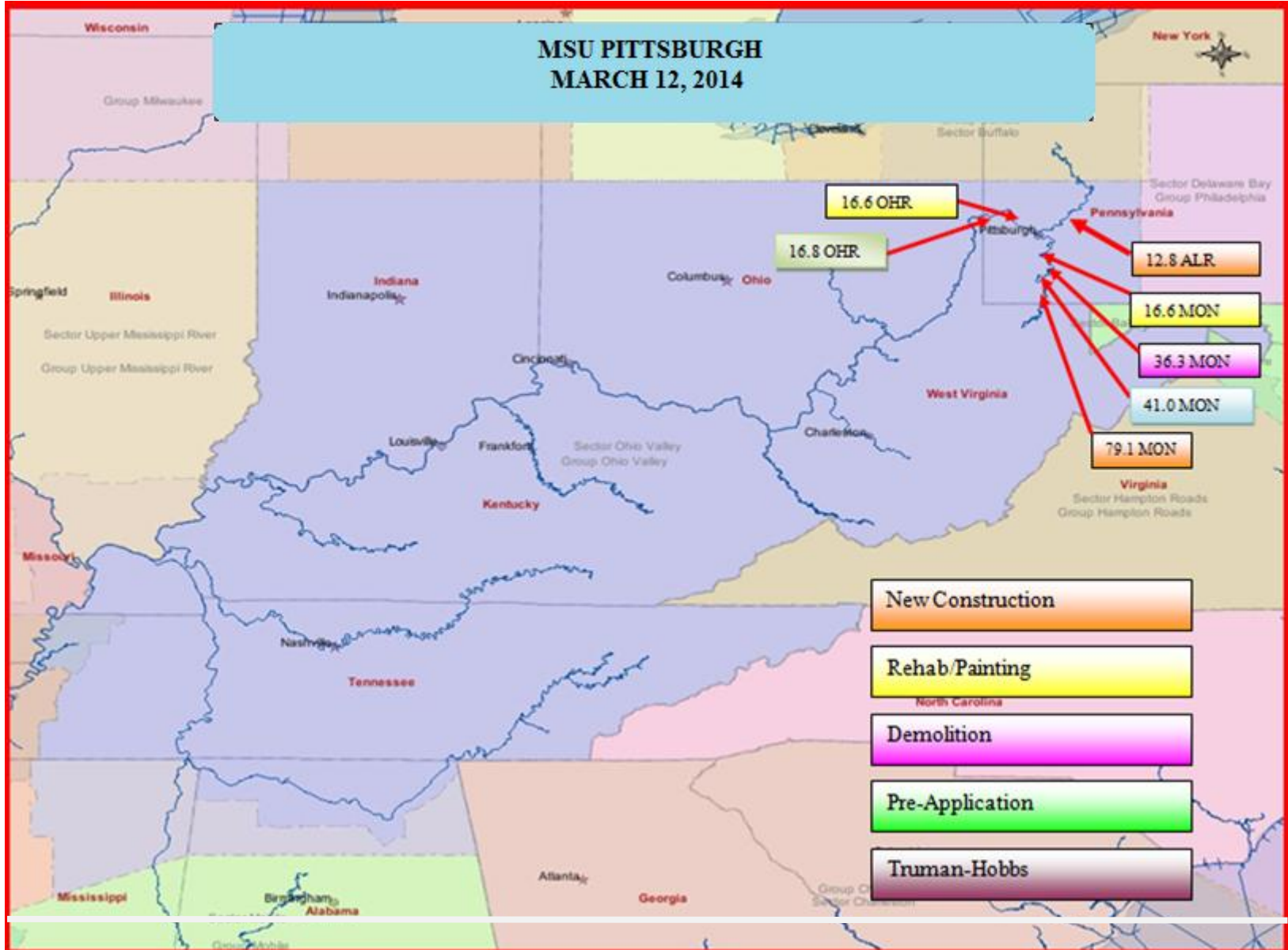

<b><u>Bridge</u></b>	<b><u>Waterway</u></b>	<b><u>Mile</u></b>	<b><u>Description</u></b>
Oakmont Bridge	Allegheny	12.8	Cofferdam construction has begun, Monday through Saturday daylight hours until October 22, 2015. 375-foot navigation channel will be maintained during construction.
Kittanning Bridge	Allegheny	45.1	Vertical Clearance is reduced to 41.6 feet due to a containment extending below low steel. Work will be conducted on the bridge Monday through Friday during daylight hours until April 2015.
William D. Mansfield Memorial Bridge	Monongahela	16.6	A containment system extends 3 feet below low steel for a reduced vertical clearance of 62.3 feet above pool stage. Work will be conducted from 7:00 a.m. until 5:00 pm., Monday through Saturday. Mariners are urged to transit the bridge with caution.
Webster-Donora Bridge	Monongahela	36.3	Bridge is closed to land traffic. Intended demolition to take place in May 22, 2014. No replacement currently planned.
Charleroi-Monessen Bridge	Monongahela	41.0	Due to shoaling, red channel margin lights located upstream/downstream on the left descending side have been moved to mark edge of this shoaling. Both center green range navigation lights have been moved 70 feet channel ward to indicate the center of the navigation channel. Horizontal clearance has been reduced to 355 feet
Masontown Bridge Replacement	Monongahela	79.1	Pier Construction of Left and Right Descending channel piers is underway. Channel is clear of obstruction, and there remains a clearance of 344ft.
Ambridge-Aliquippa Bridge	Ohio	16.8	Containment extends 3 feet below the low steel for a reduced clearance of 75.5 ft until January 20, 2013. Contact the Trumbull Corp. at (724) 333-6542 or (412) 292-9642, for status.
